Message from the Head...

Dear Parents / Carers,

Welcome back for the autumn term. It was such a pleasure to see our community arriving at school yesterday morning, and to feel the excitement at the start of the new school year. The children seemed really positive about coming back into school and were able to make smooth starts to life in their new classes. There were a few nerves for some, which is natural after such a long break, but the support of staff and caring friends helped children through any difficult moments.

We were also thrilled to welcome our new Reception Class for the first time yesterday, a big day for the children and their parents/carers, and a real milestone in their young lives. I was very impressed with how quickly the children settled into their new classroom and I am confident they will have a great year working with Mrs Wilkins, Mrs Allen, Mrs Singh and the wider team. Preschool: Tuesday with Over & In. Klee Class/Reception: Thursday (Over & In); one other session in the week. (Reception Class PE kits will not be needed this half term. Mrs Wilkins will update you when kits will be needed.)

Monet Class/Year 1: Thursday (Over & In) and Friday; Warhol Class/Year 2: Wednesday and Thursday (Over & In).

Cezanne Class/Year 3: Tuesday (Over & In) and Friday; Escher Class/Year 4: Monday and Tuesday (Over & In).

Banksy Class/Year 5/6: Tuesday (Over & In) and Friday; Hockney Class/Year 5/6: Tuesday (Over & In) and Thursday.
