Message from the Head...

Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you have enjoyed this week of fantastic weather! The children have been enjoying their PE lessons and games at break and lunchtime. Behaviour in our outside spaces has largely been very positive and the children deserve a lot of credit for the respect they are showing towards the space, the resources and each other.
