# We will be learning:

This half term we are learning about the world around us: looking at habitats; lifecycles of a variety of different animals and comparing our village to places around the world.

### **English**

Phonics – Using Little Wandle, we will be recapping phase 3 and progressing on to phase 4, looking at consonant blends. We will be continuing to blend sounds to read words and sentences.

#### **Key Texts:**

- Little Red Riding Hood
- Rainbow Fish Marcus Pfister
- On the way home Jill Murphy

The children will retell these stories, share what they like and dislike about them and innovate them to make them their own.

#### **Mathematics**

We will begin to identify missing parts for numbers within 5, explore the structure of the numbers 6 and 7 as '5 and a bit' and connect this to finger patterns and number frames. We will be looking at two equal groups (doubles) and connect this to finger patterns and we will be sorting odd and even numbers according to their 'shape'.

### **Key Vocabulary:**

Maths - odd, even, doubles, '5 and a bit'

English – digraph, trigraph, word, sentence, capital letter, full stop

**Topic** – egg, hatch, lifecycle, chrysalis, tadpole
