Message from the Head...

Dear Parents / Carers,

Our first full week in school has coincided with some changes in the weather and our first 'wet lunch' of the school year, following some excitement-generating wet and blustery weather on Wednesday. The children deserve credit from moving from the 'yellow zone' to the 'green zone', thinking about it from a <u>Zones of Regulation</u> perspective!

Children in Year 1 – Year 6 should all have brought homework home this week. For children in Year 1, we appreciate this will have been the children's first experience of this. The purpose of our homework is to allow the children to share and consolidate classroom learning, and for you to offer support and engage with your child's current classwork. We know that the support you can give your child's learning at home can help them make progress in school, so I hope the opportunity to support homework will be welcomed. We recognise that for some children and families the presence of homework may not always be positive. If you have any concerns or queries, please feel free to speak with myself, Mrs Adkins or a class teacher.

We have also been busy ensuring children have reading books and access to the usual school platforms like Times Tables Rock Stars, Accelerated Reader and Google Classroom. I will write separately about Times Tables Rock Stars, which is accessible to all children from Year 1 – Year 6. Again, I hope you will want to encourage participation in this from home.

Our PTA held their Annual General Meeting on Monday this week. The bank balance is looking healthy, thanks to the fundraising efforts of all involved and the support of our community. The team are already planning an exciting schedule of events for the year ahead, starting with a Cake Sale on 23rd September and then the first school discos of the academic year on 8th November. The tireless generosity of the PTA means that we have already been able to cover the cost of a two-day <u>stunt scooter workshop</u> with champion scooter Terry Price.
