Klee Class

We will be learning:

English

Phonics – This term we are consolidating all our knowledge from over the last year. Focusing on reading longer words by chunking and recognising tricky words.

Key Texts:

- The Three Billy Goats Gruff
- Dear Teacher by Amy Husband

The children will retell these stories, share what they like and dislike about them and innovate them to make them their own. We will be focusing on our sentence writing and how to make our sentences more exciting by using the conjunction 'and'.

Mathematics

We will recapping addition and subtraction from last half term. We will then be delving into the world of multiplication and division, looking at sharing and groupings objects.

Key Vocabulary:

Maths – add, plus, take away, subtract, equal, altogether, share, divide, groups of.

English – Sentence, full stop, capital letter, and, question mark, exclamation **Topic** – family, Grandma, Granddad, Grandparent, Uncle, Aunt, Christianity, Islam, Christian, Muslim

Topic – What do I know about my family tree

RE

We will be looking at what is special about the world. We will link this to Muddy Mondays and identify why nature is special to each of us and the benefits of being outdoors. We will then look at the creation stories of Christianity and Islam.

PSHE

Children will be creating their own family tree, looking at relationships and who is in their immediate family and their links to wider family. E.g. grandparents, aunts and uncles.
