## Message from the Head...

Dear Parents / Carers,

We were pleased to end the week with some sunshine after the wet start! The children seemed to enjoy playing outside today, and especially enjoyed our second visit from the Cambridge Kids Club Park & Play Mobil on Wednesday. This week we welcomed our Reception and KS1 children to join the fun. They had a great time!

Please note that we will have a new arrangement for entering school in the mornings, until our Year 3/4 cloakroom doors have been replaced. Reception and Year 1 children will enter classrooms through the furthest wooden gate, near the Year 1 classroom. Years 3 and 4 will enter through the first wooden gate and through the single door which Preschool also use. The children have adjusted quite well to new entry and exit points during the school day today. The replacement door is likely to be weeks, rather than days away.
