Message from the Head...

Dear Parents / Carers,

The children have returned from the half term break with positive behaviour across the school. Where we have needed to support behaviour, children have been able to reflect on their actions honestly and openly. We are proud of the progress some children have made with their honest reflections during this school year.

I have been made aware of some challenges with driving and parking in the areas around school this week. We appreciate the need for you to get children to school on time, often as part of your own busy working days, but there are a few things I think you could support us with. Please be considerate when parking outside people's homes and driveways; please consider your speed as you drive through the village and amongst the children and families walking, cycling and scooting towards school; and please avoid using the school's car park to leave your car whilst you drop children to school.
