Home learning and Uploading Weekly Tasks

The following is from Mrs Mitchell whom I introduced last week:

Each week I have been talking to the class teachers about the home learning tasks which have been set and how these arrangements are going. We really appreciate your support with your child's home learning as this can be challenging juggling everything during the day. We have changed how you need to upload the completed learning tasks and would like to inform you of these changes. This information is for years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 year groups accessing the Google Classroom.

On your child's weekly timetable, their class teacher will have highlighted a specific piece of work which needs to be uploaded each week. Your child's class teacher will look through the work that has been uploaded and write some comments to your child, providing further guidance to include in their future tasks.

If you are unsure how to upload work, guidance on your child's Google Classroom can be found. Each week a folder in your child's Google Classroom will be clearly named 'Home learning task for DD/MM/YYYY'. This is the folder where your child will need to upload their required weekly task. The work uploaded could be a photograph of the completed work or a Word document.

If you are unsure how to do this please contact the school via the school email (office@fenstanton.cambs.sch.uk) and we will support you. Thank you again for your continued support and supporting your children with their tasks, we are really enjoying looking at the work.

Workbooks
