Dear Parents / Carers,

We have had some assessments taking place in school this week, which the children have responded to really positively. Our Year 1 pupils completed their Phonics Screening, testing their early reading skills, and our Year 4 children completed their Multiplication Tables Check. Parents and carers will be informed of outcomes before the end of this term. Whilst the scores do measure individual attainment, they are most useful to us in terms of planning future provision.

Our Year 6 children all look wonderful in their leavers' hoodies, which they received on Monday this week. The weather has encouraged their use, I imagine, and we have had a reduction in lost property due to the hoodies being clearly labelled!
